



How to import resit marks

Process Overview



Step by Step Instructions

1. Click Enter Marks



Set up assessments 

Design and manage the course's assessment structure.

Set up assessments

Enter marks

Enter students' marks for assessments in the course.

Enter marks

Publish provisional marks

Publish provisional marks for components of coursework assessments to be visible to students and staff.

2. Click the drop down arrow and select Import Marks

On the resit side click the drop down arrow for the item or assessment you want and select Import Marks:

Note

If your assessment structure has an assessment with items and components, you can only import marks at the item level. This is because the system will calculate the component/assessment marks.

If your assessment structure is an assessment level only, you can import at this level.


